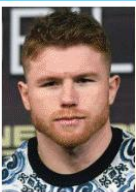

Rep. Marcoleta Champions Major Funding Boost for Barangays with House Bill 9400



Representative Rodante Marcoleta has introduced House Bill 9400, a landmark proposal aimed at providing direct financial support to barangays nationwide. This initiative targets uplifting local communities, especially in 4th and 5th class municipalities, by reallocating underutilized government funds to strengthen local governance and empower barangay officials.

A recent study revealed that only 12% of the nearly 42,000 barangays can operate sustainably, with the majority facing severe financial challenges. Many barangay captains receive as little as P5,000 per month in honoraria, a disparity that extends to auxiliary staff such as barangay tanods, health workers, and Lupon Tagapamayapa members. These financial limitations hinder the delivery of essential services, further undermining effective local governance.

Inilahad ni Assistant Secretary for Curriculum and Teaching Janir T. Datukan ang mga pangkalahatang plano at aktibidad bilang paghahanda para sa Pisa.

Sinukat ng assessment ang performance ng 15 taong gulang na mga mag-aaral sa mathematics, reading, at science.

Romero (The Island Observer), Region 4; Ramon Tolaram (Naga Times), Region 5; Aurelio Servando, Jr. (Weekly Scope), Region 6; Zoilo Dejaresco, Jr. (Bohol Chronicle), Regions 7 & 8; Armando Lopez (Zamboanga Times), Region 9; Bienvenido Cruz (Mindanao Star), Region 10; and Gil Abarico (Mindanao Mail), Region 11.

PAPI is reputedly the largest media fraternity in the Philippines today. Its membership ranks include about 400 community newspaper publishers in the regions and provinces, media executives,

RRDIC-X upskills 72 proposal preparers to secure innovation fund

The goal of the workshop is to increase the number of project proposals from Region 10 that will receive grants from the National Innovation Fund. The RRDIC-X invited seasoned innovators to train the 72 participants from the state universities and colleges, national government agencies, and local government units.

In the past, Northern Mindanao has only secured one innovation project every year. The funded projects include establishing the Farmers Information and Technology Services (FITS) Center Innovation Program in Camiguin in 2022 and the Fabrication Laboratory for Hull Research at the University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines (USTP) in 2023. Innovation is the cornerstone of progress. The Philippine Innovation Act recognizes innovation as "the creation, development, and commercialization of new or improved products, processes, or services that significantly benefit the economy and society," said Director Ratilla in her opening message.

Ms. Queritess Q. Queja, Executive Director of the Oro Chamber of Commerce, emphasized user-centric design (UCD) as a template for developing effective innovations. UCD means that designers set out to create a product that reflects the user's needs and preferences.

A winning proposal is an innovation that solves the market gaps. "We have to make sure that our innovations that we intend to propose should have a market.

Climate, disasters, education among top concerns of young Filipinos — UNICEF poll

Filipino youths consider climate change, natural disasters, education, health, and jobs among their top concerns, based on a poll of around 3,000 respondents by U-Report, the digital community of the United Children's Fund (UNICEF).

The latest poll, done online from June to July, revealed issues that matter most to the country's 13- to 24-year-olds, with a number worried about the impact of these concerns on their lives.

"About 26 percent of young people in the country believe that 'climate change and natural disasters' will be the biggest problem they'll face in the future while 23 percent are worried about not 'being able to finish their education.' 'Health (physical and mental)' and 'finding a job' are also major concerns, identified by 22 percent," UNICEF said in a press release.

"Young people see the lack of entry-level jobs (33 percent) and the current economic conditions (26 percent) as their two biggest obstacles in getting a job or starting a business in the future. Other concerns are the lack of access to quality education (20 percent) and the disruption AI technology has brought and can bring (18 percent)," it added.

U-Report's results showed that when the youths were asked what they will do as President of the Philippines to build a better future, "education, health, and economy figure in most of the answers asking the government to prioritize these critical issues".

"Other national issues mentioned extensively are corruption, agriculture, poverty, and the environment," the press release read.

"While youth are split on whether the future generation is 'worse off' or 'better off' (44 percent vs 37 percent) they do see the value that rapid technological innovations and democratic access to information can bring. They also find hope in how young people now are getting more and more involved in global issues. In fact, more than 80 percent of the respondents believe that the work of the United Nations is important in creating a better world," it added.

According to UNICEF, U-Report is a "digital community... for young people, by young people, where they can raise their voices and share opinions on topics that matter to them".

The U-Report poll results will be added to the contribution of the Philippines to the high-level UN event Summit of the Future to be held in New York this September 22, UNICEF said.

UN Philippines Resident Coordinator Gustavo Gonzalez thanked "every young person who is making their voice heard for an inclusive and sustainable world".

"New generations are bringing a reinvigorated sense of solidarity and a compelling call for collective action. Both are essential to build the future we want," he added in a statement.

For UNICEF Representative to the Philippines Oyunsakhan Dendevnorov, the poll findings "reveal the sobering, yet hopeful outlook young people have about their prospects for the future".

Dendevnorov encouraged the public to find time to listen to the young ones.

"We should listen to what they have to say and work together to address these issues so that every child is cared for, protected, and given a fair chance in life," he shared.

Sean 'Diddy' Combs arrested amid assault lawsuits

The rap mogul is the target of several civil lawsuits that characterize him as a violent sexual predator who used alcohol and drugs to subdue his victims.

Combs, 54, was arrested on Monday by federal agents acting on a sealed indictment filed by the Southern District of New York.

"We expect to move to unseal the indictment in the morning and will have more to say at that time," US attorney for the Southern District of New York Damian Williams said in a statement late Monday.

Williams did not provide further details of the charges but Marc Agnifilo, a lawyer for Combs, told The New York Times he believed the rapper was being charged with racketeering and sex trafficking.

Agnifilo said in a statement provided to AFP that Combs had voluntarily relocated to New York in anticipation of being charged.

"We are disappointed with the decision to pursue what we believe is an unjust prosecution of Mr Combs by the US Attorney's Office," the statement said.

Agnifilo said Combs was being "cooperative with this investigation" and "looks forward to clearing his name in court."

The rapper's luxury homes in Miami and Los Angeles were raided by federal agents in March in a heavily publicized bicoastal operation that indicated a federal investigation and potential criminal case was mounting against

Combs.

- Bombshell suit -

The powerful music industry figure, who has gone by various monikers including Puff Daddy and P Diddy, was widely credited as being key to hip hop's journey from the streets to the bottle-service club.

He has amassed vast wealth over the decades, not least due to his ventures in the liquor industry.

However, despite his efforts to cultivate the image of a smooth party kingpin and business magnate, a spate of lawsuits describe Combs as a violent man who used his celebrity to prey on women.

The artist has denied all accusations against him. Combs has no major convictions but has long been trailed by allegations of physical assault, dating back to the 1990s.

The floodgates opened late last year after singer Cassie, whose real name is Cassandra Ventura, alleged Combs subjected her to more than a decade of coercion by physical force and drugs as well as a 2018 rape.

The pair met when Ventura was 19 and Combs was 37, after which he signed her to his label and they began a romantic relationship.

The bombshell suit was quickly settled out of court but a string of similarly lurid sexual assault claims followed - including one in December by a woman who alleged Combs and others gang-raped her when she was 17.

Disturbing surveillance

video then emerged in May showing Combs physically assaulting his then-girlfriend Ventura, corroborating allegations she made in the now-settled case.

- Global fame with dark shadow -

Born Sean John Combs on November 4, 1969, in Harlem, the artist entered the industry as an intern in 1990 at Uptown Records, where he eventually became a talent director.

He gained a reputation as a party planner, which would be central to his brand as his fame rose.

In 1991 he promoted a celebrity basketball game and concert at the City College of New York that left nine people dead after a stampede.

The event was over capacity by thousands and resulted in a string of lawsuits, with Combs blamed for hiring inadequate security.

Combs boasted a number of major signed acts and production collaborations with the likes of Mary J Blige, Usher, Lil' Kim, TLC, Mariah Carey and Boyz II Men.

He was also a Grammy-winning rapper in his own right, debuting with the chart-topping single "Can't Nobody Hold Me Down" and his album "No Way Out."

He built an image as a brash hustler with unapologetic swagger, a major producer who also ventured into Hollywood, reality television and fashion and had high-profile romantic links with the likes of Jennifer Lopez.

But a dark history of violence and serious misconduct has long haunted his fame.

Both actors are stepping into legendary characters. Hemsworth voices the noble Optimus Prime while Henry is the complex villain Megatron. To the actors, "Transformers One" is not just an action-packed, visually stunning spectacle, but also a story driven by profound emotional connections and themes of identity, love, and transformation.

Before Optimus Prime, there was Orion Pax, a worker bot who dreams of doing something bigger for his community. "I think it sort of resonates with a lot of people, most of us I hope," said Hemsworth about his character yearning to be something more.

"The idea that we have some influence on our journey in life, and that our path isn't sort of preordained. It has a lot to do with the work and commitment and our own passion, our own sense of hope and what we want to achieve, or what we believe is possible."

Meanwhile, Henry's approach to playing Megatron, a character synonymous with villainy in the Transformers universe, goes far beyond the typical portrayal of a ruthless antagonist.

For him, unlocking Megatron's origin was the key to understanding the character. "I've always had a fascination with villains, especially from our youth," he said. "In cartoons, when they present them to you, it's just like, you always hate this guy. I'm like: there's got to be more."

The actor added: "Villains are diehard; they're going to rally behind what it is that they want to change, and usually it's something that they've discovered and being disillusioned."

"What they thought was real isn't really what it is. And so that's what I wanted to bring to Megatron. But I also really loved the connection between he and Optimus—like to realize that they actually are thick as thieves."

Directed by Josh Cooley, the new take brings fans back to the origins of Optimus Prime and Megatron's relationship, exploring their once-strong bond before it fractured into the bitter rivalry that defines their future battles. Hemsworth channeled Optimus Prime's leadership and resilience and leaned into the character's calm authority.

Henry, meanwhile, sought to capture the intensity and inner turmoil of Megatron, ensuring that his portrayal carried both gravitas and vulnerability.

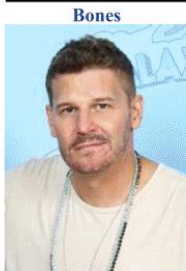

The veteran trio of LA Tenorio, Ian Sangalang, and Cliff Hodge will be recognized by the PBA Press Corps when it holds its 30th Awards Night on Sept. 24 at the Novotel Manila Araneta City.

World No. 1 Swiatek withdraws from Korea Open

Organizers of the Korea Open said Swiatek, a five-time Grand Slam singles champion, withdrew from the competition due to fatigue.

They said the Polish player told them she was not back to 100 percent following the U.S. Open last week and was forced to alter her schedule.

She promised to visit Seoul for next year's tournament, the organizers added.

Swiatek is one of five current or former top-10 players to have withdrawn from the Korea Open.

Jessica Pegula, the defending champion with a Korean-born mother, will miss her title defense here due to a rib injury. Pegula, world No. 3, knocked off Swiatek in the quarterfinals of the U.S. Open before losing to Aryna Sabalenka in the final.

World No. 4 Elena Rybakina, the 2022 Wimbledon champion, has hit the sidelines with a back injury, while eighth-ranked Emma Navarro, the U.S. Open semifinalist, has changed her schedule. Karolina Pliskova, former world No. 1 and 2014 Korea Open champion, is dealing with a foot injury.

With these withdrawals, the 2017 U.S. Open champion Sloane Stephens and the 2021 U.S. Open winner Emma Raducanu have moved into the main draw. Raducanu was a fan favorite at the 2022 Korea Open, when she reached the semifinals — her first trip to the last four at a tournament that year.

The Korea Open starts Saturday with qualifying matches at Olympic Park

Pinoy boxer Melvin Jerusalem at Mexican Luis Castillo handa na sa harapan nila

Loman identifies weakness in his game after loss to Lineker

After getting dominated by former bantamweight champion John "Hands of Stone" Lineker at ONE Fight Night 14 in September 2023, the Filipino believes he has identified the only glaring hole remaining in his game.

Surprisingly, Loman is focusing on striking as the one facet of his arsenal that needs improvement.

Against Lineker, Loman tried to no avail to take the fight to the ground, all the while the Brazilian veteran overwhelmed him on the feet en route to a unanimous decision win.



His first loss in seven years may turn out to be beneficial for bantamweight MMA contender Stephen "The Sniper" Loman.

The do-it-all Hodge will be hailed as the Defensive Player of the Year, while Tenorio and Sangalang are the recipients of the Bogs Adornado Comeback Player of the Year award from the group of sportswriters regularly covering Asia's pioneering pro league.

Hodge, 36, averaged 9.6 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 3.2 assists while providing hustle plays and hard work not reflected in the stat sheets.

A part of the Bolts since 2012 when he was selected fourth overall in the PBA Rookie Draft, Hodge played a major role in Meralco's first ever championship. The Bolts had stunned the San Miguel Beermen in six games in last season's PBA Philippine Cup Finals.

Hodge joins the likes of Marc Pingris, Chris Jackson, Arwind Santos, Freddie Abuda, Chris Ross, June Mar Fajardo, among others, who were past recipients of the award.

Tenorio and Sangalang

on the other hand, will be honored for their successful return to active duty after their respective bouts with career-threatening illnesses.

Sangalang was previously diagnosed with hyperthyroidism that led him to miss the rest of the league's Season 47 with Magnolia. Tenorio's health condition was an open case the moment the Barangay Ginebra team captain announced he was stricken with stage three colon cancer. His situation made him skip the Season 47 Governors' Cup that finally ended his league record of 744 consecutive games played.

But following their respective treatments, both Sangalang and Tenorio are back in the pink of health and playing again for their respective teams, healthy enough to receive the special award named after PBA great William "Bogs" Adornado, who successfully came back from two career-threatening knee injuries and became a three-time league MVP.

The result marked the end of Loman's 11-fight winning streak dating to April 2016.

"I did not believe in my striking," he admitted. "That's why I turned to my wrestling. I [stuck] with my wrestling even though I was connecting with my shots."

"I clocked him with my jabs and straights. When he kicked, I caught it. I should've stuck with it to see if I could get him with my striking," he added. For Loman, he lacked the confidence in his striking to keep the fight standing — even when he was tagging Lineker with shots of his own. In his willingness to get the fight on the ground, he felt like he forgot the other aspects of his game.

"If my counter had been wrestling, all I did was just shoot for the takedown without even setting it up with my strikes," he said. "I think I really lacked the timing, the set-ups, and I just vanished. My offense just vanished. He defended everything."

That lack of commitment comes from what he feels are shortcomings in his striking, a surprise considering that Filipino fighters are known for that aspect of their game. Making it all the more surprising is that Loman competed out of one of the best striking camps in the Philippines — Team Lakay — before leaving the gym after the fight.

"Those were the lessons I learned. I need to improve on my mistakes and improve my striking," Loman said. "I am really lacking in boxing. I'll improve on everything — set-ups, timing, boxing, everything really. So I can be a complete fighter."

Nakuha naman ni Marianna Gillespie ang overall winner sa women's competition sa loob ng tatlong taon habang sa men's category ay nakuha ni Petar Klovar ng Croatia na nag-uwi ng gold sa FIM discipline na may 12.7 meter dive at bronze sa CWTFB.
