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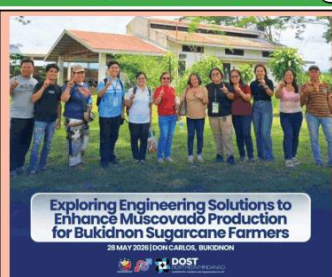

The conference gathered business leaders, entrepreneurs, innovators, and development partners across the province to discuss opportunities, collaborations, and strategies that will further strengthen South Cotabato's growing economy and thriving business ecosystem.

A highlight of the event was the participation of Hon. Governor Reynaldo S. Tamayo Jr. during the Governor's Hour, where he shared significant developments on the province's improving economy and the continued

growth of its Gross Domestic Product (GDP), emphasizing the province's commitment to inclusive growth and sustainable development.

Meanwhile, Provincial Director Giselle Eve O. Siladan presented the various Programs, Projects, and Ac-

Exploring Engineering Solutions to Enhance Muscovado Production for Bukidnon Sugarcane Farmers



Sugarcane farmers of the Bukidnon Farmers CARP Beneficiaries Multi-Purpose Cooperative (BUKIFCAMP) in Don Carlos, Bukidnon continue to produce quality muscovado sugar as a source of livelihood and community pride, yet operational challenges and production bottlenecks can limit their efficiency and growth potential. To better understand these needs and identify appropriate interventions, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Bukidnon conducted a Technology Needs Assessment (TNA) on May 28, 2026, as part of its continuing efforts to support farmer-led enterprises through science, technology, and innovation.

On the same day, DOST Bukidnon also met with the Central Mindanao University-Mechanical Engineering Department to explore possible technical solutions and areas for collaboration that may help address the cooperative's operational concerns. Through this initiative, potential opportunities for process improvement, enhanced productivity, and better product quality were discussed, laying the groundwork for future science and engineering-based interventions. By fostering collaboration among farmers, academic institutions, and government agencies, the activity supports the development of practical solutions that can help strengthen local enterprises, improve competitiveness, and create greater economic opportunities for sugarcane farming communities while addressing operational constraints that may affect long-term growth and sustainability.

DOST-PCIEERD, USTP open built environment laboratory in Northern Mindanao

(Photo courtesy of the USTP Strategic Communication Office)CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY (PIA) — The Department of Science and Technology-Philippine Council for Industry, Energy and Emerging Technology Research and Development (DOST-PCIEERD) and the University of Science and Technology of the Southern Philippines (USTP) inaugurated the Built Environment Laboratory (BEL) on May 28 at the USTP Cagayan de Oro campus.

The facility will serve as a research center for studying, developing, and testing building designs and construction materials suited to tropical climates. The laboratory aims to support efforts to reduce carbon emissions and lower energy consumption in academic and urban structures. Project leader Engr. Richard Jayson Valera said the laboratory seeks to address increasing energy demands for cooling amid rising temperatures. "Ang atang main goal dinhi, e-relate natin sa current nga sitwasyon sa kalibutan, is para e-minimize gyud natin ang consumption sa air conditioners. If ma-minimize natin ang consumption sa air conditioners, magamay ang consumption sa university," he said. (Our main goal here, relating it to the current

situation of the world, is to really minimize the consumption of air conditioners. Valera said the laboratory will use engineering tools and localized weather data to study passive cooling strategies, climate-responsive building systems, and technologies that help regulate indoor temperatures while reducing energy use. He added that the research outputs from the facility will support the university's operations and provide data that local government units and private developers can use to plan and design energy-efficient buildings in Mindanao. The project is part of the collaboration between DOST-PCIEERD and USTP to advance research on energy-efficient and climate-responsive infrastructure in Northern Mindanao. It supports President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s push for climate resilience, energy efficiency, and science-driven innovation as part of the country's sustainable development agenda. DOST-PAGASA Explains Connection Between Habagat, El Niño, and Heat Index Amid Changing Weather

As many areas continue to experience intense morning heat and sudden afternoon rains, the Department of Science and Technology Ilocos Region (DOST Ilocos Region) continues to step up its efforts to provide timely updates about the country's weather and climate. In response to many questions from the public after Episode 8 of Tekno PreSyensya, the agency hosted a follow-up discussion through Episode 10, titled "Bantay Ulat Panahon: Habagat-El Niño Outlook and Heat Index Monitoring." The program featured Engr. Mark Louie A. Vergara, Weather Specialist II from DOST-PAGASA Northern Luzon, who cleared up confusion about current weather conditions and what to expect in the coming months.

Engr. Vergara explained that while the country's weather is currently normal, there is a 79% chance that a strong El Niño will develop between June and August, which could last until the early part of 2027. He corrected a common misunderstanding that the extreme heat we are feeling right now is already caused by El Niño. In fact, the start of El Niño is expected to bring more rain and stronger storms to the western part of the country first. This is because it pulls and strengthens the southwest monsoon (habagat), long before the actual dry weather and water shortage happen toward the end of the year.

The discussion also focused on Tropical Cyclone Jiangu (locally named Domeng). While the storm is not expected to hit land, it is helping trigger the official start of the rainy season by pulling the habagat winds toward the country. This transition is the reason behind the sudden, heavy afternoon rains currently experienced in parts of the region, which are caused by localized thunderstorms that form after hours of intense morning and midday heat.

The episode also broke down the concept of the heat index, or the "apparent temperature"—which is how hot the weather actually feels to the human body based on the air temperature and relative humidity (the amount of moisture in the air). When humidity is high, the body struggles to sweat and cool itself down, making the air feel heavy and sticky. The agency warned that these conditions can cause severe stress to crop and farm animals and pose serious health risks like heat exhaustion and heat stroke, especially for outdoor workers like farmers, street sweepers, traffic enforcers, and construction workers. To stay safe at home, Engr. Vergara shared practical tips, advising residents to open windows on opposite sides of the house to create a natural breeze. He warned that running an electric fan inside a closed, unventilated room is unsafe because it only circulates the trapped hot air. The public was strongly urged to check DOST-PAGASA's official heat index forecasts regularly, and to immediately treat any signs of heat stress with proper rest, continuous hydration, and staying out of direct sunlight.

Batay sa datos mula Mayo 12 hanggang Mayo 31, isinaalalim ang Visayas grid sa red alert sa loob ng 22 interval hours at sa yellow alert sa loob ng 93 interval hours. Sa parehong panahon, ang Luzon grid naman ay nakaranas ng red alert sa loob ng 27 interval hours at yellow alert sa loob ng halos 5.5 interval hours.

DOST strengthens Mindanao textile industry with launch of first Regional Yarn Production and Innovation Center



KABACAN, Cotabato — The Department of Science and Technology–Philippine Textile Research Institute (DOST-PTRI), in partnership with the University of Southern Mindanao (USM), officially launched the Regional Yarn Production and Innovation Center (RYPIC) in Kabacan, Cotabato on June 5, 2026, marking a significant milestone in the development of Mindanao's textile industry.

As the first facility of its kind in Mindanao and the fourth in the country, RYPIC is expected to improve access to locally produced yarn, strengthen regional textile production, and create new economic opportunities for farmers, weavers, and rural communities across the island.

DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum Jr. described the facility as a major step toward decentralizing innovation and bringing technology-driven development closer to communities. He noted that the establishment of RYPIC demonstrates the commitment of DOST-PTRI under the FRONTIER Program to strengthen local industries through regional innovation hubs, enabling communities to benefit directly from science and technology interventions.

The center addresses a growing demand for yarn in SOCCSKSARGEN, which DOST-PTRI data identifies as one of the country's leading regions in handloom weaving communities and practicing weavers. Strategically located in Cotabato, the facility is positioned to serve weaving communities across SOCCSKSARGEN, Northern Mindanao, the Davao Region, and the Zamboanga Peninsula.

According to DOST-PTRI Director Dr. Julius L. Leano Jr., the launch of RYPIC is not only about establishing infrastructure but also about developing a textile innovation ecosystem that connects fiber producers, yarn manufacturers, weavers, research-

ers, local governments, and industry stakeholders. He emphasized that the initiative combines technological innovation with the region's rich textile traditions, creating a foundation for sustainable growth while preserving cultural heritage and supporting local livelihoods.

The facility is expected to become a critical link in the region's growing textile value chain. Fiber sources include pineapple leaves from plantations in Polomolok, South Cotabato; abaca from Lake Sebu; and cotton from farms in Sarangani Province, all processed through the Natural Textile Fiber Innovation Hub in Tacurong, Sultan Kudarat.

By transforming agricultural by-products into valuable textile materials, the initiative promotes circular economy practices while opening additional income streams for farming communities. Farmers can now derive value not only from their primary agricultural products but also from materials that were previously considered waste.

DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations Engr. Sancho A. Mabarrang highlighted the broader socioeconomic impact of the facility, noting that its annual production capacity of approximately 13 tons of natural textile fiber blended yarns can help generate sustainable livelihood opportunities for rural communities throughout SOCCSKSARGEN and the rest of Mindanao. He underscored that the initiative demonstrates the growing competitiveness of Philippine natural textile fibers and their potential to meet both local and international market demands.

The project is expected to directly benefit farming groups such as the POLO Multi-Purpose Cooperative and Sta. Cruz Multi-Purpose Cooperative, while supporting approximately 1,982 handloom weavers across Mindanao through improved access

to locally produced yarn.

Further strengthening the region's textile industry, DOST-PTRI is also advancing the development of a bamboo textile fiber facility in Maramag, Bukidnon. The upcoming facility will process undensitized bamboo species into textile fibers, complementing the operations of RYPIC and expanding the range of sustainable raw materials available for yarn production.

Once fully operational, the center is projected to produce between 50 and 75 kilograms of yarn daily, equivalent to approximately 270 meters of handloom-woven fabric measuring one meter in width. With yarn valued at around P1,800 per kilogram, the facility is expected to generate between P25 million and P72 million in annual revenue while reducing dependence on imported yarn and stimulating greater weaving activity throughout Mindanao.

Through investments in regional innovation infrastructure, sustainable fiber development, and community-based production systems, RYPIC represents a significant step toward building a resilient Philippine textile industry that creates opportunities from farm to fabric while empowering communities across Mindanao. COMPLAINT

PLAINTIFF, by counsels, unto this Honorable Court, respectfully alleges that:

1. Plaintiff, **GLOBAL DOMINION FINANCING, INC.** ("GDFI" for brevity), is a corporation organized and existing under Philippine laws, with office address at Unit 201, Jollibee Plaza Condominium, Emerald Ave., Ortigas Center, Pasig City. To prove this, attached herewith is a machine copy of the Certificate of Filing of Amended Articles of Incorporation issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission, and the Certificate of Authority No. 530 issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission, and made an integral part hereof as **Annexes "A" and "B"** respectively.

2. The Plaintiff is represented herein by its duly authorized legal representative, **ELIZA G. GALING-BESABE**, Filipino, married and of legal age, as evidenced by Plaintiff's Secretary's Certificate, a machine copy of which is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof as **Annex "C"**, it may be served judicial processes through said representative at Unit 5 C & D, 5th Floor, Strata 100 Building, F. Ortigas Jr., Rd., Ortigas Center, Pasig City.

3. Defendants are **CHRISTINE ERICA ORDINARIO GONZALES and RALPH LAWRENCE BAISAC GONZALES**, Filipino Citizens, married and of legal ages, and with residence address at **831 Carola St., Sampaloc, Manila** ("Defendants GONZALES" for brevity) where they may be served with summons and other judicial processes.

3.1 Defendant John Doe is an unknown person/s who may be in actual possession or control of the vehicle, in violation of the rights of GDFI, which is the subject matter of this action. The identify and other personal circumstances of Defendant John Doe shall immediately be disclosed to this Honorable Court the moment they are ascertained by the Plaintiff;

4. On July 29, 2023, Defendants GONZALES for valuable consideration, executed and delivered to Plaintiff a Prom-

issory Note with Chattel Mortgage, under such terms and conditions therein specified, in the amount of **EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED PESOS (Php 869,400.00)**, with a contractual interest rate of 1.25% per month, payable in **Thirty six (36)** monthly installments, in the amount of **THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND EIGHTEEN PESOS (Php 35,018.00)** per installment, beginning **August 29, 2023**. A machine copy of said Promissory Note with Chattel Mortgage are hereto attached and made integral parts hereof, respectively, as **Annexes "D" to "D-2"**.

5. In order to secure payment of the subject Promissory Note, Defendants also executed in Plaintiff's favor a Deed of Chattel Mortgage, duly registered with the Registry of Deeds under such terms and conditions therein provided, over a motor vehicle of which **CHRISTINE ERICA ORDINARIO GONZALES** is the registered owner in fee simple, said motor vehicle being more particularly described as follows, to wit:

6. All the terms of the loan agreement between Plaintiff and Defendants GONZALES, including contractual interest rate, penalties, charges and fees, were reduced into writing through the Promissory Note with Chattel Mortgage abovementioned. Said document was executed by both the Plaintiff and Defendants GONZALES, evidencing their free and voluntary consent to be bound by all the terms thereof.

7. Defendants GONZALES defaulted in their payment of the monthly installment in violation of the terms and conditions of the Promissory Note and Deed of Chattel Mortgage. For this reason, Plaintiff demanded from Defendants the payment of the whole balance of their obligation which, as of **February 12, 2026**, has amounted to **SIX HUNDRED ELEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY THREE PESOS AND TWENTY CENTAVOS [PHP 611,693.20]**, exclusive of penalties, interests and other lawful charges. A copy of the statement of account is hereto attached as **Annex "H"**. The clause No. 5 of the Promissory Note with Chattel Mortgage provides for an acceleration clause, or the immediate payment of all sums due in case of default. Additionally, under clause No. 26 of the same document provides that Defendants are likewise obligated, in case of default, to deliver the vehicle subject of the mortgage to Plaintiff, in order that the same may be foreclosed, and the proceeds of the sale shall be retained by herein Plaintiff to answer for the debt of the defendants.

Clause no. 5 and 26 of the promissory note which chattel mortgage state that:

5. "Failure to pay this note or any installment thereof, when due and without need for prior notice or demand, shall constitute default for purposes of any action of any kind instituted against me/us by the GDFI, and shall render the entire amount owing due and demandable without prior notice".

26. shall be without prejudice to charging the MORTGAGOR any deficiencies in this account and to whatever balance he may still have with the MORTGAGEE”.

8. Demands were made upon **Defendants GONZALES** to settle their obligations or, in the alternative, to surrender possession of the vehicle. By reason of Defendants’ unjustified and obstinate refusal to comply with their prestations, Plaintiff was constrained to institute the complaint-at-bar if only to protect its rights and interests. A copies of the demand letter, SPEX Official Receipt and LBC Transaction Details are here- to attached as **Annexes “I”, “J”, and “K”** respectively, and made integral parts hereof.

9. As mortgagee, Plaintiff is entitled to the possession of the motor vehicle herein above described, together with all its accessories, equipment, and appurtenances, if any, pursuant to the provisions of the Promissory Note and Chattel Mortgage, as said **Defendants GONZALES** and John Doe are wrongly and unlawfully detaining the same for the purpose of defeating Plaintiff’s mortgage lien thereon. Further, said mortgaged motor vehicle has not been taken for any tax assessment or fine pursuant to law, nor has it been seized under execution or attachment against Defendant’s property; or if so, the same is exempt from seizure.

10. Plaintiff is ready, willing, and able to post a good, sufficient, and solvent bond in such amount twice the actual value of subject motor vehicle, which, for Replevin purposes, is valued at **EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS [PHP 800,000.00]**, for the return of the same to the Defendants if the return there- of should eventually be adjudged, and for the payment unto the Defendants of such sum as may be recovered against the Plaintiff, which now claims physical delivery of the mortgaged vehicle.

11. Plaintiff intends to present **ELIZA G. GALING-BESABE** as witness. The witness will testify on and prove the averments in the Complaint, and claims and causes of action of Plaintiff, that the Defendants obtained a loan from the Plaintiff and executed loan documents such as the Promissory Note with Chattel Mortgage and Disclosure Statement of Loan/Credit Transaction in favor of Plaintiff; that Defendants secured a loan with the subject motor vehicle; that Defendants defaulted in the payment of their loan obligation; that Defendants failed to settle said obligation; and that Plaintiff is entitled to the issuance of Writ of Replevin. The witness will also identify documents and will testify on important matters in relation to the Complaint. Attached hereto and made an integral parts here- of as **Annexes “L”, “M”, “M-1 to M-4” and “N”** in support of Plaintiff’s prayer for the issuance of a Writ of Replevin, as herein prayed for, an Affidavit of Merit executed by Eliza G. Galing-Besabe, an Affidavit of Valuation executed by Maricar J. Delos Angeles, Screenshots of Valuation from the Internet and a Verification and Certification of Non-forum Shopping executed by Eliza G. Galing-Besabe.

12. As provided for by the 2019 Revised Rules of Civil Procedure, the Judicial Affidavit of the Plaintiff’s representative is herewith attached and made an integral part hereof as **Annex “O”**. The Judicial Affidavit identifies and discusses documents that will prove the averments in the Complaint, as well as the claims and causes of action of the Plaintiff.

13. The Plaintiff’s documentary and object evidence are attached to this Complaint, as follows: Certificate of Filing of Amended Articles of Incorporation issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission as Annex A; Certificate of Authority No. 530 issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission as Annex B; Secretary Certificate as Annex C; Promissory Note with Chattel Mortgage as Annexes D and D-2; Affidavit of Good Faith and Annotation of Registration as Annex D-6, D-10 and Disclosure Statement on Loan/Credit Transaction as Annex E; Official Receipt and Certificate of Registration of Motor Vehicle as Annexes F and G; Statement of Account as Annex H to H-1; Demand Letter, SPEX Official Receipt and LBC Transaction Details as Annexes I, J, and K; Affidavit of Merit of Eliza G. PRAYER

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully prays that:

1. Immediately upon filing of this Complaint, an Order be issued against **Defendants GONZALES, and JOHN DOE** granting the issuance of a Writ of Seizure/Replevin, upon filing by Plaintiff of a Replevin Bond in such amount as may be fixed by this Honorable Court, and directing the Sheriff or other proper officer of this Honorable Court forthwith to take custody of the motor vehicle and upon due notice and hearing, a judgment be issued declaring and confirming Plaintiff’s lawful and permanent possession of the vehicle and further ordering **Defendants GONZALES, and JOHN DOE** to pay Plaintiff attorney’s fees, damages, premium for replevin bond and such other expenses incurred relative to the seizure of the subject motor vehicle, at such amount as shall be proven during the trial on the merits, together with cost of suit;

2. Or in the alternative, and in the event that manual delivery of subject motor vehicle cannot be effected, judgment be rendered in Plaintiff’s favor and against **Defendants GONZALES, and JOHN DOE** ordering the latter to pay the former the following:

- (a) Actual damages in the amount of to **SIX HUNDRED ELEV- EN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY THREE PESOS AND TWENTY CENTAVOS [PHP 611,693.20]** exclusive of 15% penalty and 10% penalty interest for each unpaid monthly amortization and;
- (b) Attorney’s fee in the amount of 25% of the total amount due,
- (c) Cost of suit.

Plaintiff prays such other relief that this Honorable Court may deem just and equitable under the premises.

Tributes pour in for Etheridge as he retires from PH squad

Goalkeeper Neil Etheridge has announced his retirement from the national team, ending an 18-year journey defined by passion, sacrifice, leadership and historic achievement.

In his Instagram post, Etheridge reflected on the highs and lows of representing the Philippines, the country he chose to serve as an 18-year-old despite being born and raised in England.

"Love and heartbreak. Passion and desire. I never stopped caring, I always gave everything for the team and the country," Etheridge wrote.

"All I wanted from the beginning was to make a difference and I hope that I was able to achieve that with my service to the country and national team."

Philippine Football Federation (PFF) president John Anthony Gutierrez paid tribute to Etheridge's unparalleled service to Philippine football.

"Neil Etheridge helped change the trajectory of Philippine football. His courage, professionalism, and unwavering commitment to the country inspired a generation of players, particularly world class goalkeepers, and his legacy will forever be woven into the story of our game," Gutierrez said in a news release Saturday.

"On behalf of the Philippine Football Federation, we thank Neil for 18 years of extraordinary service. While his

national team duty has come to an end, the impact he made on Philippine football will continue to be felt for generations," he added.

All 13 players of the legendary "Miracle of Hanoi" squad that stunned defending Southeast Asian champion Vietnam in 2010 have now retired.

Etheridge, who joined the national team at 18, earned 82 international caps between 2008 and 2024.

"I made my decision to play for the Philippines. Qualified for the first time ever to the Asian Cup for the country, First Filipino player to ever play in the Premier League. I made some amazing friends along the way and met some great people. Memories that will last with me forever," Etheridge, the first Filipino and first Southeast Asian footballer to play in the English Premier League in 2018, recalled.

Playing for Cardiff City, he saved a penalty on his Premier League debut before earning the club's Player of the Year award and the Philippine Sportswriters Association's Mr. Football of the Year honor.

National team veteran fullback Daisuke Sato thanked Etheridge for "leading the way and setting the standard for all of us" while former national team assistant coach and Miracle of Hanoi goal scorer Chris Greatwich called him "the best

ever."

"The national team stands on the shoulders of your efforts over the past two decades," Greatwich said.

Current winger Alex Monis summarized best the feelings of the current crop of players.

"True legend that inspired generations, teaching me what it means to represent this country," Monis wrote on social media. (PNA)
